Please do not eat or drink after 12 midnight the night prior to surgery.

Day of Surgery: Important Guidelines

- You may brush your teeth the morning of your surgery.
- You may bathe, but please do not use make-up, hair spray, toiletries or nail polish.
- Wear casual, loose-fitting clothing as you will change into a surgical gown.
 - For <u>hand surgery patients</u>, please wear something with large, flexible sleeves and remove any artificial nails.
 - o For <u>shoulder surgery patients</u>, a loose fitting **%** utton up the front+shirt is preferable.
- Please leave contact lenses at home. If that is not possible, please be sure to bring a storage case for them.
- Leave all jewelry and valuables at home. If you have body piercings, please remove before surgery. Otherwise, the Center will ask you to remove them.
- A responsible adult must be available to transport you to and from the center. Please
 note that a parent and/or guardian of a minor must remain in the building the entire time
 the minor is present.
- Arrange for a ride home. A responsible adult must accompany you home since you will not be allowed to drive, use public transportation, or walk.
- A responsible adult must stay with you for 24 hours after discharge from the surgery center
- Once you arrive at the facility, you will be asked to complete necessary paperwork including permission to release information to your insurance company.
- Bring your insurance ID card.
- Bring a photo ID card such as a drivers license.
- If you have an advance directive, please bring a copy with you for your chart.
- If a co-pay, co-insurance or personal payment is due, please bring it with you. We accept cash, personal checks, VISA and MasterCard.
- If you have been given an assistive device such as sling, walker or crutches, please bring it with you the day of surgery.
- Please let us know if there are any cultural, ethnic or religious beliefs that may influence the type of care we provide for you.
